The classical African civilizations of ancient Kush and Nubia are in jeopardy of being permanently flooded by a series of dams along the Nile River in northern and central Sudan. Time is limited for SNP director **Prof. Manu Ampim** and his research team to document the remaining archaeological evidence before the flooding begins. The mission will require \$50,000 to complete and help influence UNESCO to begin protection of the sites.
